Write the word, its part of speech (noun, adjective, verb, etc.) and its definition.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Make Some Music</u></b></p> <p>Write a song or rap that includes your words! Underline the words in your lyrics.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Pyramid Words</u></b></p> <p>Write your spelling words in a pyramid shape. Start with the first letter. On the next line, write the first two letters. Continue until you have written the entire word.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Example: them  t  th  the  them</p>
